We want to say thank you because everything was very organized. We had a program of seminar, a list of lectures and we easily found the information on your site



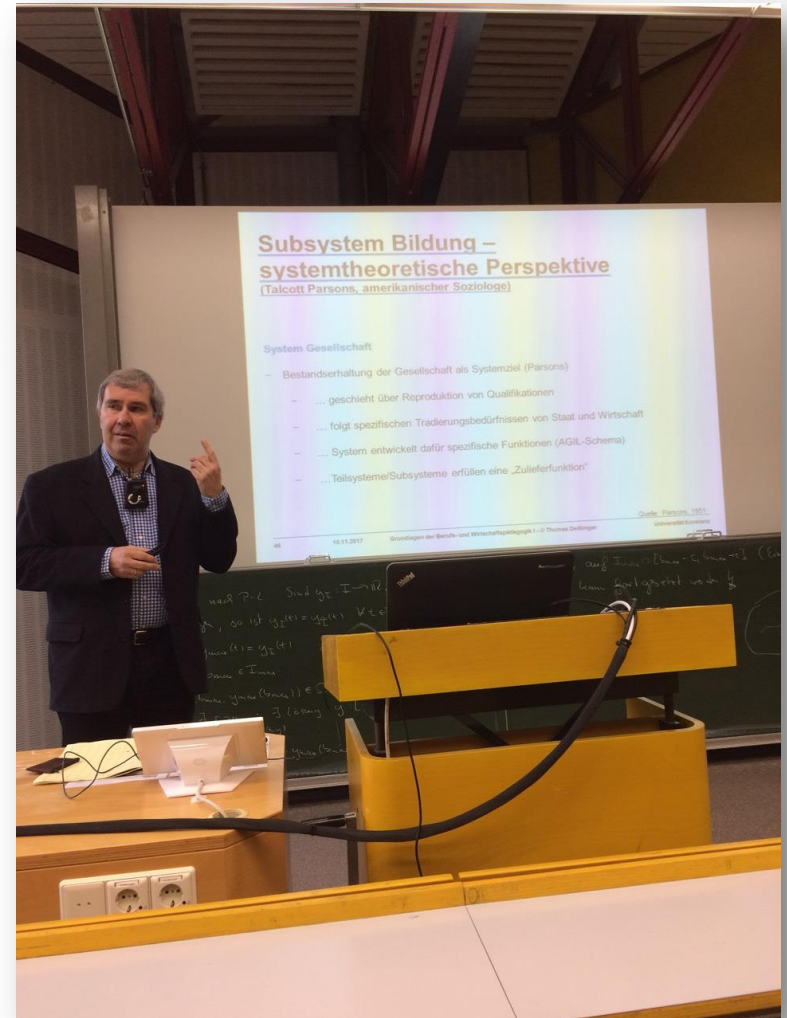

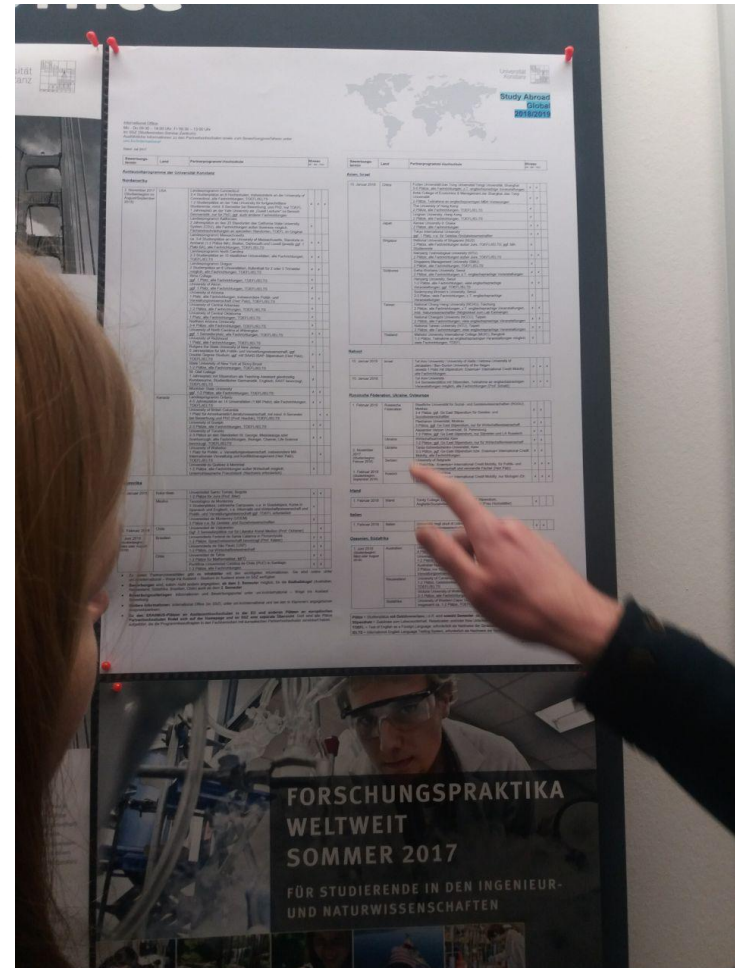


Most of all I liked lectures of Introduction to Personnel Management and International Finance because of useful information, relaxed atmosphere and interesting life stories.

Also, I was pleasantly surprised at how much time is spent in your university for practical study. This is very lacking in Ukrainian education.

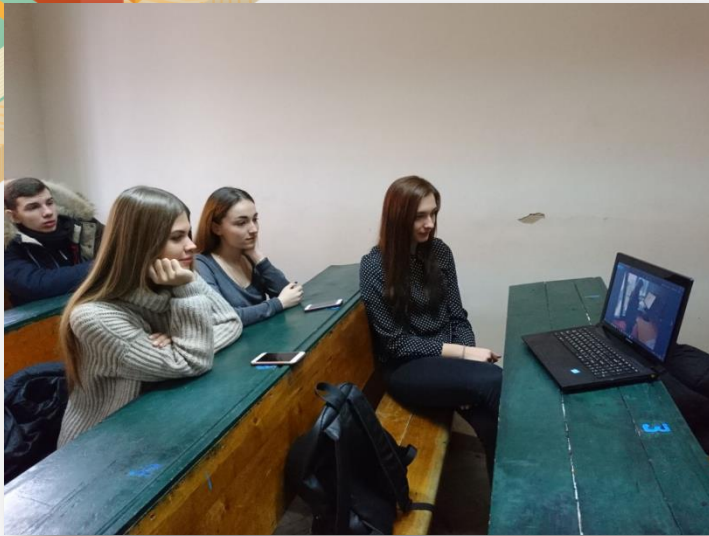


I understood the sense of the phrase
