Course description: In the first part of this course, we will discuss theoretical and

empirical political economy studies that examine the process of policy making in democratic regimes. Among other, we will discuss direct voting procedures, standard models of electoral

competition in representative systems, and agency models.

The second part focuses on different topics that currently receive great attention in the political economy literature. For each of these topics, we will study the theoretical foundations.

We will also read recent empirical papers on these topics.
